Terms of Use

THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS (THE "TERMS") ARE A LEGAL CONTRACT BETWEEN YOU AND THE ARC OF THE Greater Prince William ("THE ARC"). THE TERMS EXPLAIN HOW YOU ARE PERMITTED TO USE OUR WEBSITE <u>WWW.THEARCGPW.ORG</u> AND RELATED SITES LINKING THESE TERMS (INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY, THE "SITE") AND THE SERVICES AVAILABLE THROUGH OUR SITE (COLLECTIVELY, THE "SERVICES").
